



In pursuance of a warrant dated Ap^d 3^d 1793 there was Survey'd for James Guthrie the above described Tract of Land containing three hundred acres and an allowance proportioned to Six p Cent Situate in Salem Township in the County of Westmoreland Survey'd February 6^d 1797.

There is a Warrant in the Name of Sam'l Moorhead dated June 19th 1786 that appears to have been taken for the above described Tract of Land and a copy of it put into my hand about two or three Years ago by Geo. T. Albeit of Philad - but when I applied to Mr. Moorhead he disclaimed the Land and said he had bought a trifling Improvement before he had ever seen the Land but after he had obtained the Warrant he examined the Land and made enquiry where the lines of the adjoining Surveys were he thought it was not good enough to lay his Warrant on it and that he had taken the Warrt to M^r Elder and got him to make a Survey on it in his District and that the Survey made by M^r Elder was Returned
