



By Virtue of a Warrant dated 1<sup>st</sup> of July 1784 or as Surveyed by Alexander McDowell then Deputy unto John Scott the above described Tract of Three hundred and sixty six Acres & 70 perches of Land and Allowance on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of April 1785 Situated adjoining Mountains Mountain about one mile from the west branch of Susquehanna River and Lands of David Jones and others in Turbot's now Point Township and examined and Certified this fifth Day of April 1802.
