W<sup>e</sup> the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela & Yohogaea and this do hereby certify that Robert Taylor assignee of James Clemons is intitled to four hundred Acres of Land on the Waters of Buffalo creek in the County of Ohio to include his settlement made in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and seventy four.
