



The above described tract of One hundred and eighty four acres and fifteen perches of Land and allorances is part of a larger tract of two hundred and eighty two acres & an half with the allorances situate in Anttrim (now Washington) Township, Cumberland (now Franklin) County which was surveyed to Gustavus Brown the 20<sup>th</sup> day of April 1752. In pursuance of his warrant dated 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1751. Resurveyed and divided off the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1806.
