

The above Draught describes two Parcels of Land belonging to Philip Tanner situated near Little Elk in East Nottingham Township Chester County called Mount Rocky wth 45 acres & 21 pches & allowance is the North East Part of the Lott No. 36 originally surveyed for John Beals in the year 1702 & Resurveyed the 11th of the 11th Mo (April) 1788 In pursuance of a Warrant to one directed bearing date the 29th of November 1787. And 41^{1/2} pches is the Northern Part of a Tract formerly surveyed for Robert Holt adjoining the East side of said Beals's Lott by Warrant bearing date the 23rd of May 1741.
