Begins at A post thence south seventy Degrees West By Vacant Land one Hundred and sixty two perches to a post half A perch distant from A mark a white oak tree thence north twenty Degrees West by Vacant Land one hundred and eighteen perches to A Hickory tree thence north seventy Degrees East by Vacant Land one hundred and seventeen perches to A Chestnut tree thence South forty Degrees East by Vacant Land one hundred and twenty two perches to the place of Beginning Containing virtually seven acres and all orance Surveye the fourth Day of January Anno Domini one thousand and seven hundred and thirty eight - witness my Hand and Seal at Harrisburg this
