

Michael Bear not complying & dying without paying for his Survey for y<sup>e</sup> 97<sup>th</sup> & it became void & he having made no payment for y<sup>e</sup> 113<sup>th</sup> & nor any Warrant ever granted for the same John Bear his son after his fathers decease obtained a Warrant on the — day of June 1741 for a Return of both Tracts In pursuance of both under one description Returned y<sup>e</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> of June 1741.

The Returns above Mentioned not being to be found in the Secretaries Office the warrant to Michael Bear for the 97<sup>th</sup> Dated the 19<sup>th</sup> of January 1733 was vacated by warrant of the 11<sup>th</sup> of January 1748 and to be Returned for the use of Abraham Bear and by <sup>Warrant</sup> of the same day ~~the~~ Requiring me to accept of the Survey made in right of Martin Kundingg and to Return the same for the use of the said Abraham which was accordingly done the 11<sup>th</sup> of Jan 1748
