Part B was originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Benj. Cunningham dated the 16th June 1798. Part C was originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Benj. Cunningham dated the 29th day of June 1798. Part D containing 10^{1/2} & allowance surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Robert I. Cunningham and Benj. F. Cunningham for 10^{1/2} bearing date the 18th day of February 1852. On the 15th & 16th days of April 1852 resurveyed the whole and protracted in one plot at the request of Robert I. Cunningham Benj. F. Cunningham & Stephen W. Cunningham the present owners to make return thereof for Confirmation
