



A Draught of a tract of land called—situate on the waters of Tunkhanrock Creek where the waters of said Creek and Mashapping Creek are about a mile apart and about twenty two miles from the mouth of Mashapping Creek following the courses of said Creek in the County of Northumberland. Including within the bounds of this survey the Tracts or Lots Numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9, and containing in the whole the quantity of two thousand seven hundred and eighty six acres and nineteen perches besides the usual allowance of Six p Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the twenty fourth, twenty fifth and twenty sixth days of September 1775 for Benjamin Chew Esq. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the twentieth day of August 1774.

Returned into the Secretary's Office the 30<sup>th</sup> of April 1785
