

Situate on the west side of Yough<u>iogeni</u> River in Henry Clay township Fayette county (1½ miles below Smithfield) and Surveyed the 29th day of June 1835. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Jacob Bell for 400^{as} dated the 10th day of February 1794.

There is about 70 acres cleared, two dwelling houses, a sawmill. The improvement is about 20 years old & now occupied by Jonas Critchfield.
