Called No 2 Both Surveyed for the heirs of William Plumstead Decade and directed to be confirmed to them by Patent per order of the Honourable Board of Property dated the 1st day of July 1793 Resurveyed and laid off the above parts for the executors of John Brown Decade the 22nd day of May 1826.
