By William Maclay late Deputy Surveyor & said to contain 260.8 acres &c In pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Cochran the 8th day of March 1765.

Notes The Piece coulerd Yellow on the above Draught shows a part of the tract survey of for W^a Cochran- and which was included in a Survey (shown by the Dotted lines) made for Samuel Finley the 29th of September 1762 said to contain 204 103 &c. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1st day of June 1762

N. B. The courses bearing 548 W 27½ from a W.O to Post & N32½W SI to a Pine appear to have been left open lines & not mark. It is a samuel Cochran Esquire
