



Situate in Tyrone Township York County and Surveyed May 20<sup>th</sup> 1775 unto Peter Spangler In pursuance of a Warrant granted unto a certain Thomas Beaty bearing Date April 1<sup>st</sup> 1751 The Right of which is by sundry Mesne Conveyances now vested in the said Peter Spangler,----and which said Warrant as the above Tract lay directly within the Location thereof, and being unsettled at the Time of the Granting the said Warrant to the said Beaty, and he the said Spangler having purchased the Right of the same to prevent Evil, and no other Land having been Surveyed under said Warrant, I was Induced as with the consent of the said Spangler, to pay so far back for his Land tho' it not settled until some years afterward, it would not prejudice the interest of the Proprietaries, to run Round the Whole Tract of Land and submit the acceptance of the Survey unto the Honourable Board of Proprietaries, to run Round the Whole Tract of Land and submit the acceptance of the Survey unto the Honourable Board of Proprietaries.
