

Situate in Paradise Township York County Containing as above set forth five acres ninety six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c Being part of a larger tract of 293½ acres & allowance, Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 8th day of May A.D. 1753 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Killian Fissel for —os dated the 29th day of March A.D. 1753. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract; on the 16th day of November A.D. 1791 and now at the request of Conrad Fissel the present owner of said part, the Draught is examined, corrected and returned for Confirmation. February 4th 1822.
