Being part of a larger tract of 293½ acres & allowance Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 8th day of May 1753 in pursuance of a Warrant for —as granted to Killian Fissel dated the 29th day of March A D 1753. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 26th day of September 1803, and now at the request of Catharine Wiest the present owner of said part, the Draught is exampled, found correct, and returned for confirmation
