

Containing one hundred and thirty two acres & allowance of six per cent for roads&c A Draught of two detatched pieces of Land situate in Letterkenny Township (formerly Cumberland) now Franklin County being parts of a Tract of 327 as 102 ps & allowance which was surveyed the 12 to february 1762 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Robert Gabby bearing date the 17th of October 1749 - The above described parts appears to have been Surveyed and laid off the 27th of April 1797 as by a Draught thereof signed Daniel Henderson then Deputy Surveyor of said County, which Draft I have examined and recalculated this 13th of May 1822.
