We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Yohogania Monongolia & Ohio Do hereby Certify that James Craig is entitled to four Hundred acres of Land in the County of Yohogania on a Branch of Redstone Creek to include his Settlement made in the year 1776.

Day of December 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
