

Situated on Bowland's Run a branch of Redstone Creek in Franklin Township Fayette County and Surveyed the 9th day of June 1786 In Consequence of a Certificate Issued by the Commissioners appointed to settle the Claims to unpatented lands in the Countries of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio— of which a true copy is annexed

We the Commissioners for adjusting claims to unpatented lands &c in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that James Craig is intitled to four hundred acres of land on a branch of Redstone-in Yohogania County to in-clude his Settlement made in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy six.

Given under our hands this Twenty second day of December 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
