



Tract in Beach Bottom Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 182rd & 12 perches and the allowance being part of a larger tract of 3rd 6th & 3rd 36 perches and the allowance which was originally surveyed to James Ell Alexander the 19th Day of January A.D. 1793 in pursuance of 2 warrants in his own name one for 200rd dated December the 5th A.D. 1785 the other for 40rd dated February 7th A.D. 1787 and now on the 29th Day of May A.D. 1839 at the request of Robert Criswell the present owner I have calculated, corrected & returned it for said Criswell who wishes to patent it
