



A Draught of a tract of Land, Situate in Upper Roxborough Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania, Containing one Hundred and Eighty Two Acres and Sixty Two Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per Cent for Roads. That was formerly Surveyed for Jacob Dreicer in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 22^d. August anno. 1758 - who sold his Right to the same to other Persons, who again to Jacob Lingel, and he again to David Smith, and he again to George Birding, to whom it was resurveyed on the 17th February anno 1762.
