



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1773 a Survey was made on the 3rd day of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Dumbury in the County of Northumberland for Edward Board Esq; marked in a general Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Sixty Seven, Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Dumbury Street Sixty feet, and in length North and South on the West side of Center Alley Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Dumbury Street aforesaid, Eastward by Center Alley, Northward by Strawberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number one hundred and thirty. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 24th day of November 1773 by Warrant dated the 2^d of November instant.
