



A Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Franklin Township in the County of York, Containing one hundred and Ninety Acres, and the Allowance of six acres per cent. for Roads and Highways; One hundred and Thirty Five Acres, part thereof is part of a Larger tract of Two hundred and Seventy Acres Survey for Conrad Berkhauser, by Zachariah Butcher in pursuance of a Marrant bearing Date the 3rd Day of October 1758, and fifty five Acres the Residue of the said One hundred and Ninety Acres, Surveyed the 6th Day of November 1762 for the said James Miller by virtue of a Marrant granted unto George Berkhauser, and bearing Date the 6th Day of August 1755. The Height of both which pieces of Land is said to be vested in or Bargained and sold unto the said James Miller, at whose Request I have surveyed the said two pieces into one tract and that by the ancient Lines thereof, as the same had been formerly surveyed by George Stevenson
