



Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> of March C.D. 1844 to Samuel Dixon the above described tract containing thirty eight acres and one quarter of an acre and allowance of six per cent situate in Centre township Indiana County (but formerly Armstrong township Westmoreland County) adjoining lands originally surveyed and claimed by James Wilkins William Marshall Alexander Moorhead and others By virtue of a Warrant granted to John Ellison the 6<sup>th</sup> day of February 1794

Took - There is an improvement on the land which (from statements of the old settlers) I believe has been kept up for fifty years or upward
