



Draft of abstract of land containing two hundred and seventy four acres & allowance of six per cent for roads, including an improvement of Sharon Adams, consisting of a dwelling house & thirty or more acres of land cleared & fenced - begun the first day of June 1796 and continued by situation and near the forks of Big Roehoopy creek in the township of Branham County of Eugene. Surveyed the 9th & 10th days of March 1813 in pursuance of a warrant dated September 1st 1812.
