



A Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Letterkenny Township in the County of Franklin (formerly in the County of Cumberland) Containing four hundred and sixteen Acres and 100 Perches and the allowance of six p. cent. for Roads &c. Surveyed November 10<sup>th</sup> 1786 agreeable to what has been alleged to be the lines of the original Survey made in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Anderson bearing Date the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1753, a part of which, however hath been claimed under a Warrant granted to Reuben Gillespy dated the 30<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1785, and the matter in dispute decided in the Supreme Court in favor of the Claimant under Anderson's Warrant
