



A Draft of a tract of land situate in Peters Township in the County of Franklin containing one hundred and sixty acres and 141 perches and the allowance of six R. Cent. for Roads &c. including, as is alleged, a tract of eighty acres and allowance formerly surveyed on a Warrant to Thomas Waddell dated 11<sup>th</sup> April 1751, as appears by a certified Copy of the Return of Survey, but the lines of said Survey cannot now be ascertained - Andrew Biggar the present owner hath obtained a Warrant for the Residue bearing Date the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1789, for which Warrant there remains eighty Acres & 141 Perches and allowance undistinguished in the above Draft for the Reason above mentioned.
