Sir - the John Shilling was located by our Court according to the above sketch - for the reason ^{that} it called for Siding Hill the Mt was Issued in 94 and calls for Joseph Alexander which is located on Beaufort Hill. Besides there are no marks it becomes necessary to reverse all the courses and streams contrary to nature to locate on Beaufort Hill.
