



Pursuant to a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated May y^e 24th 1776 Survey'd unto Thomas Betts a certain Tract of Land (according to the above Plan) Situate in the Township of Buckingham & County of Bucks - Begin-ning at a Stone in Durham Road and Thence extending by the Land Survey'd to the said Thomas Betts & Land in Possession of ^{of Mrs. Sunders} the two Courses following viz. North 42 Degrees East 198 Perches to a Stone and North 79 Degrees East 111 1/2 Perches to a Stone Thence by Land in Possession of James Sample the four Courses following viz. South 26 Degrees East 24 1/2 Perches to a White Oak and South 5 Degrees East 15.4 Perches to a Black Oak and South 1 Degree West 45 Perches to a Stone and South 15 Degrees West 48 Perches to a Stone, and South 28 Degrees West 59.3 Perches to a Stone ~~to a Stone~~ in Durham Road aforesaid; Thence along the said Road by Land in Possession of Isaac Kirk North 74 Degrees West 119.5 Perches to the first mentioned Place of Beginning Containing Eighty five acres & 153 Perches and allowance of 6 acres p^r Cent or ninety one acres & twenty Perches Strict measure. As to the Quality of the Land. the Soil has been pretty good but has been long worn and is scarce of Timber. The Buildings are a Frame House one story high about 16 feet wide & 40 feet long. and a frame Barn about 18 Feet wide & 40 feet long that both want repairing and some other out Buildings of no great Value. about an acre & half or two acres of Orchard and about three & four Acres of Meadow. not much of it to be called good. and but very little constant Water on it.
