

Draft of a tract of land situate in the Township of Hanover one of the seventeen townships of Luzerne County being part of lot numbered 7 in the first division of lots in said township adjoining lot N-b & part of No.7, containing one hundred eight acres and nineteen perches of land besides the usual allowance of 6 pr.Ct. for roads &c. Surveyed the above described tract of land the fourth day of April 1837 for Jonathan Slocum by virtue of his warrant dated the 13th day of February 1837.

Surveyor General The above described tract of land was also surveyed same time on warrant of same date as above to P.M.Gilchrist – I have thought it best to make returns on each – Mr. Gilchrists warrant was left at my office in Kingston on the 15th day of Feby—and the warrant of Jonathan Slocum was put into my hands in Huntingdon on the 18th day of the same month - From the best information in think it probable a certificate under the State Commissioners was issued to Gideon Baldwin a connecticut claimant – for the same tract of land – Al the time Mr. Gilchrist's warrant was left at the office in Kingston—The question was asked Elias Hoyt who had charge of the office whether or not he was authorized to execute warrants and the bearer of the warrant was informed that he had no deputation but a verbal one.
