

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela & Yohoganea & Ohio do hereby Certify that Francis Miller is intitled to four hundred acres of land in the County of Ohio on the Waters of Buffalo Creek to include his Settlement made in 1774 Also a Right in preemtion to 1000 Acres adjoining thereto

Given under our hands at Cox's fort the seventeenth day of Feby 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
