



Situate partly in Washington, but principally in Franklin, formerly Canaghaw Township, in the county of Forks, Containing as above set forth, 59¹/₂ & 79 perches and allowance 800 ft long by 400 ft wide. Being part of a larger tract of land which was originally surveyed in pursuance of Daniel McFerren's Application No. 4824, dated the 23rd day of March 1868. Resurveyed and divided off from said larger tract of land the second day of May 1867, and at the request of Elaron B. Finkler, Jacob Lehner and Michael Niley, returned for confirmation.
