



W<sup>m</sup> M<sup>c</sup> Keene's Warr:  
dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Decr 1749

By Virtue of an order to me Directed by John Lukens Esq: S.G. bearing date the 2nd of December 1783 in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property to Survey & Resurvey & divide the several Tracts of Land which George Cochran claims by Warrant to William M<sup>c</sup> Keene & which James Steel claims by Warr to himself dated 17<sup>th</sup> Decemr 1773 And the Land of William M<sup>c</sup> Cleary which he claims under sd M<sup>c</sup> Keene's Wt and for excluding the Land within M<sup>c</sup> Cleary's Survey which Cochran has recovered of him in an Action in Chester Court, have Surveyed unto George Cochran the above Described piece of Land Situate in West Fallowfield or Oxford Chester County, being the Land recovered of sd M<sup>c</sup> Cleary as above mentioned. The Red lines dividing between M<sup>c</sup> Cleary & the above piece of Land & between the above piece of Land & Steel's Claim was run agreeable to Evidences produced & is run & marked agreeable to the present Situation of the Needle, Variation two degrees & a half. Witness my hand this 20<sup>th</sup> day of Decemr 1783.
