As there appears to be no certain Office right by which the within tract has been held I wish to give all the information concerning it possible. I shall therefore give a Copy of the Chain of Title from the present as far as it recites — [¶] "It being part of a tract of twenty six acres and allowance that was formerly Surveyed for Isaac Sumney by virtue of a Warrant from the Honorable Proprietors Dated on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April — A.D. 1756 who sold sixteen acres thereof to John Shuler, who conveyed the same to Jacob Zieber and to his heirs and assigns. And whereas the said Jacob Zieber by Deed Poll under his hand and seal bearing date the — day of — A.D. 1793 for the consideration therein mentioned did grant & confirm the above mentioned <sup>and described</sup> seven acres and one hundred and forty seven perches of Land and allowance part of the aforesaid sixteen acres unto the said John Bolich (party hereto) and to his heirs and assigns Relation being therewith had more fully will appear" [¶] The said John Bolich and Margaret his wife on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1832 By Deed Poll conveyed the same to the said Jacob Dimmig and George Kline Esq<sup>r</sup> which by my Survey contains 8 Acres 39.89 perches including the run. —
