In pursuance of the Hon^bble the Proprietaries Warrant granted to John Shelby and Robert Smith bearing Date the 29th October 1772 resurvey'd the 23^d March 1775 the above described Tracts of Land situate in Peters Township in the County of Cumberland --- The Tract to John Shelby containing three hundred and eighteen Acres and sixty four Perches and an Allowance of Six sh^c Cent for Roads &c and the Tract to Robert Smith containing three hundred and twenty five Acres thirty two Perches and Allowance as aforesaid.
