We the Commissioners for adjusting the claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahela & Ohio and Ohio do Certify that the Executors of George Wilson are intitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Monongahela situate on the River Monongahela to include his improvement made in the year 1772 given under our hands at Cox's Fort the tenth day of Feby 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
