



3rd 4th & 5th of Sept^r And 11th of Decr A.D. 1846 and 20th & 22nd of February A.D. 1847 Surveyed to Dougall Leech the above described tract of three hundred and twenty acres and one hundred and nine perches and allowance of six per cent situate on the waters of Blacklick Creek in Brushvalley township Indiana County (formerly Wheatfield township Westmoreland County) By virtue of two warrants one granted to William Holmes 20th of March A.D. 1787 for 150^{acres} and one granted to Archibald Woodsides 19th of February 1793 for 200^{acres} In the first described warrant to William Holmes there in hereby now returned 128^{acres} 20 perches & allowance and on the latter described warrant to Archibald Woodsides there is now returned 192^{acres} 89 perches & allowance See the accompanying return of Holmes & Woodsides Both of which said Warrants filed in this office are endorsed "Executed" 12th Octr 1807 there is also on file a manuscript draft of survey a copy of which with every superscription pertaining to it is hereby transmitted (which see on the back of this paper)
