The dotted lines and River represent the draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed on 2 warrants for Ralph Aston & William Loyd dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of December 1762 this tract Interferes one Hundred and Eighty six & one half acres with the Persifer Fraser Survey — Ralph Aston and William Loyd conveyed to John Little and John Lukens — who conveyed to Jacob Grieb — who conveyed John Gripe who conveyed to John Wise & Conrad Geasy the present owners — To Jacob Spangler Esqr. S.G.
