Notes The part call'd vacant appear survey'd the 30th of March 1793 & August 12th 1794 by virtue of a warrant Granted To Henry Hubbell the 30th of March 1786 — and the part call'd Henry Hubbell appear survey'd the 21st day of Novr 1785 — In pursuance of a Warrant Granted To Samuel Brown the 24th day of June 1785 — William Junken Esq: claims part of the above Tract of Land survey'd for Ferdinand Finata By virtue of a Warrant for 100^{as} in the name of Jane Betty Dated the 20th day of September 1794 bearing Interest from the 1st of May 1774 — and altho there is still remaining more Land than sufficient to fill his Warrant agreeable to its Boundaries yet appears not satisfied — I am of opinion that it is no more than justice to Return the Survey of F. Finata as it was made by Lyon
