



A Draft of A tract of Land situate in St. Clair township Bedford County. containing five Hundred & Forty four acres and one hundred & sixty seven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c so surveyed for Christian Snyder on Warrant dated the 1st day of June 1763. No 1 represented by the dotted lines is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for James Sterling on order No. 1370 dated the 26th day of September 1766. this tract Interferes sixty Eight Acres and twenty six perches with the Christian Snyder survey. James Sterling conveyed to James Hunter who devised the same to James Hunter the present owner. No 2 partly represented by green lines is part of a Draft of a tract of Land surveyed for Ephriam Williams on Warrant dated the 22nd day of August 1785. This tract interferes twelve acres and one hundred and sixty one perches with the Christian Snyder survey. Ephriam Williams conveyed to Thomas Kickroy from whom the same was sold by the Sheriff of Bedford Co to Frederick Dubbs the present owner. N.B. An Improvement made 25 years ago by Leonard Berkheimer Interferes it is supposed to the amount of 100 acres with Christian Snyder survey. Leonard Berkheimer sold the same to Jacob Burkhardt of Greenfield township who now claims the same - no survey has been made on said settlement or Improvement To Gabriel Heister Esq^r S.G.
