



The above Draught made by the black lines contain 12 acres & 14 perches of Land and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situated in Colerain township, Lancaster County, and is part of a larger Tract or Survey mad by Ge^r Churchman D.S. the 30th of Decr 1754 in pursuance of 5 several Warrants granted to John McConel, two of them dated April 19th 1754 (and Indorsed on the back of said Survey as containing 240 acres) and in that survey, each Warrant or Survey thereon, is designated by a Letter of the Alphabet, viz, A, B, C, D, E, and this Survey of 12 acres & 14 perches, is a part of the Warrant and Survey marked D, the dotted lines Represent the other parts of said larger Survey &c.
