



Situate on Canoe Creek at the east end of Turfey now Scotch Valley, in Frankstown township Huntingdon County
Containing three hundred and sixty four acres, and ninety one perches and allowance of six per cent. Surveyed the 8th
day of September 1766 for James McCune on Order No. 534 dated the 1st day of August 1766.

Benjamin Wyncoop No. 1736 Pat'd

The dotted lines represent the draught of a tract of land surveyed for Benjamin Wyncoop on Order No. 1736
dated the 29th day of October 1766. This tract interferes three hundred and sixty four acres and ninety one perches
with the James McCune Survey.

Benjamin Wyncoop conveyed to Edward Duffield who also purchased from James McCune. Edward Duffield conveyed
to James More who devised to James and Matthew Buchanan the present owners.
