No. 1 represents part of the draught of a tract of land surveyed for John Keer & Thomas Weems on warrant dated the 8th day of October 1774 this tract interferes forty four acres and ninety four perches with the John Freeman Thomas Weems & John Keer who conveyed to John Gripe who conveyed to Jacob Shively who conveyed to Henry Mogle the present owner and to Mr. Hasle who devised his part to widow & heirs his widow married Dr. Baker who with the heirs of Hasle are the present owners No. 2 represents the draught of a tract of land surveyed for Thomas Weems on warrant dated the 29th day of March 1774 This tract interferes one hundred and eighty nine acres and thirty three perches with the John Freeman Survey Thomas Weems conveyed to John Gripe who conveyed to Christian Yontz who devised the same to his widow and heirs the present owners The widow married Henry Mogle who claims her interest in said land
