No 1 represented by the dotted and black lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed

for James Anderson on warrant dated the 8th day of March 1803 this tract interferes nine acres and one hundred and twenty eight perches with the John McCallister survey James Anderson conveyed to John Shell who also bought from Dr. John Anderson who claimed under John McCallister John Shell conveyed to John Corley the present owner

No 2 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for George Woods Jr on warrant dated the 26th day of July 1793 this tract interferes thirty one acres and one hundred and four perches with the John McCallister survey

John McCallister conveyed to John Bell who conveyed to Dr. John Anderson acting Executor of George Woods Jr Deced who obtained the aforesaid warrant Dr. John Anderson conveyed to Peter Dull from whom the same was sold by the

Sheriff of Bedford County to Matthias Smith the present owner No 3 represented by dotted lines is part of a draught of a tract of land surveyed for George Woods Jr on warrant dated the 5th day of July 1793 this tract interferes thirty four acres and one hundred and eight perches the descent of which is in respects the same as the above
