



A Draft of A Tract of Land situate in the head of Pigeon Cove in Bethel township, Bedford County. Containing Two Hundred and thirty two acres with allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Richard Malone on Order No. 5247 dated the 15th day of November 1768. No 1 represented by the green lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Jacob Boorman on Warrant dated the 14th day of March 1794. This tract interferes seventy five acres & thirteen perches with the Richard Malone Survey. Richard Malone conveyed to John Lee who conveyed to Christian Cowell who conveyed to John Rush who obtained the aforesaid warrant in the name of Jacob Boorman - Jacob Boorman conveyed to John Rush from whom part of this land was sold by the Sheriff of Bedford County to William Tod who conveyed to Andrew Young who conveyed to John Rush who conveyed to Peter Morgerett who conveyed to George Morgerett the present owner. The residue of the tract John Rush conveyed to Isaac Bonnett who conveyed to Jacob Fisher the present owner. No. 2 represented partly by dotted lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for John Rush on warrant dated the 25th day of December 1795. This tract interferes one hundred and and sixty four acres and one hundred & fifty nine perches with the Richard Malone Survey. Richard Malone conveyed to John Lee who conveyed to Christian Cowell who conveyed to John Rush who obtained the aforesaid warrant and conveyed part of said tract to Isaac Bonnett who sold to Jacob Fisher the present owner. The residue of said tract was sold from John Rush by the Sheriff of Bedford County to William Tod who conveyed to Andrew Young who conveyed to John Rush who conveyed to Peter Morgerett who conveyed to George Morgerett the present owner. No. 3 represented partly by the late couloured lines is a draft of A tract of land surveyed for James Mitchell on Order No. 3257 dated the 30th day of March 1767. This tract interferes One hundred & fifteen acres with the Richard Malone Survey. James Mitchell conveyed to John Lee who also purchased from Richard Malone and conveyed to Christian Cowell who conveyed to John Rush from whom the same was sold by the Sheriff of Bedford County to William Tod who conveyed to Andrew Young who conveyed to John Rush who conveyed to Peter Morgerett who conveyed to George Morgerett the present owner. No. 4 represented by dotted lines is the draft of a tract of land surveyed for John Rush on order No. 1765 dated the 31st October 1766. This tract interferes thirty acres and sixty seven perches with the Richard Malone Survey. John Rush conveyed to Peter Smith who conveyed to Jacob Fisher the present owner. No. 5 represented by dotted and green lines is part of a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Peter Heise on warrant
