



A draft of A tract of land situate in Martin's Cove in Southampton township Bedford County containing two hundred and forty four acres and seventy nine perches and allowance of six per cent for roads & so Surveyed for William Christy the 25th day of December 1791 on Order No 1752 dated the 30th day of October 1766.

No. 1 represented by the dotted lines is part of A tract of land surveyed for Lemuel Barrett on order No. 1346 dated the 24th day of September 1766. This tract interferes sixty eight acres and sixty two perches. Lemuel Barrett conveyed to Captain Thomas Bassett who conveyed to Charles Coxel (who also purchased from William Christy) who conveyed to Amos Dickens, who devised the same to Jesse Dickens and Stephen Dickens the present owners. No. 2 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for Thomas Barnsley on Warrant dated the 1st day of June 1763. This tract interferes one hundred and seventy acres and seventy nine perches and allowance with the William Christy survy. Thomas Barnsley conveyed to Capt? Thomas Bassett who conveyed to Charles Coxel who also purchased from William Christy and conveyed to Amos Dickens, Thomas Leathem and William Burns. William Burns conveyed to Amos Dickens who devised the same to Jessie Dickens & Stephen Dickens the present owners of part of said tract. Thomas Leathem conveyed to Eliza Perdew Esqr the present owner.
