Part B & C is an Interference of a tract of 53 1/4 acres & alike surveyed on warrant for 50 as to Jacob Huntsecker.

(alias Hunsuire) dated 23d October 1749. Patented to Henry Liner junr. 9th April, 1788.

Part B is now owned by John Linert above named, and part C by Henry Boyers, Magdalena Boyers, and Michael Linert, containing 11 acres & 123 ps, all situate in Manheim Township. Witness my hand
