



By virtue of a warrant from the Court of Common Pleas bearing date —————— 1681. Laid out for William Baull a tract of land called Wilburn situated and being on the west side of Delaware River, & between the land of Cristian Clanson called Utinburg and the land of Hermann Ericks about halfe a mile above Pearonink.

Begining at a corner marked Spanish oak being the westernmost corner tree of sd Clansons standing by the side of Delaware River fr(b) thence N N W by sd Clansons line of mar(obl) trees 320 perches to a corner marked white oak from thence N S W by a line of marked trees 96 perches to a corner marked black oak and from thence S S W 30 perches to a corner marked black oak standing by the side of a small branch, from thence S S E by a line of marked trees 310 perches to a corner marked black oak of Hermann Ericks(obl) standing by the river side at the mouth of a small runn then up by sd River side E 6 N to the first mentioned Spanish oak containing 200 acres of land.
