



By vertue of a warrant from the court att Upland bearing date March ye 10<sup>th</sup> 16<sup>79</sup> 80.  
Layed out for William Clayton a tract of land & marsh called Ridgwick situated and beeing on the west side of Della-  
ware River & on the east side of the scole Creek.

Begiring at a corner marked hickore standing by sd creek, from thence east 84 perches to a corner marked black oak,  
from thence S. E. b. S by a line of marked trees 240 perches, to a corner marked black oak, then N.E. b. E. by a line of marked trees  
to a corner marked read oak from thence N. W. b. N. by a line of marked trees, 260 perches to a corner marked white oak standing at ye  
100 perches read oak from thence down sd branch on severall courses 120 perches to a corner marked black oak standing at the  
head of a smal- brinish from thence down sd branch on severall courses 120 perches to the first mentioned hickore contain-  
ing 215 acres of fast land.

The above sd marsh lyeth N.E. about a mile from sd land Begiring at a corner marked white oak standing by a swamp side  
from thence N. W. b. N. 56 perches to a corner marked wt. oak standing by sd marsh then N.E. 161 perches to a corner marked black  
oak from thence 50(61) 48 perches to a corner marked read oak. then S.S.W. 25 perches to the first mentioned white oak containing  
6 acres of marsh land.
