

By virtue of warrants one from ye Proprietary and Govern<sup>t</sup>: Bearing date ye 25<sup>th</sup> of ye 11<sup>th</sup> mo 1683. ye othe<sup>r</sup> from ye Com<sup>r</sup> bearing date ye 24<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> moneth 1688 directed to ye Surveyor Generall I do hereby authority from him certifie into ye Secretaryes office that there was surveyed and laid out ye 25<sup>th</sup> of ye 5<sup>th</sup> 1688 unto Andres Swanson Boons ~~in~~ severall tracts of land in ye County of Chester<sup>t</sup> ye first pece or p'cell beginning at a corne<sup>r</sup> marked White oak standing by Muckernipate Creek thence E.N.E. by a line of trees four hundred perches to a corne<sup>r</sup> past thence S.S.E. by N.W Woods land one hundred perches to a corne<sup>r</sup> marked red oak thence W.S.W. by a line of trees one hundred seventy six perches to a corne<sup>r</sup> past thence S.23<sup>d</sup> Easterly by Morten Mortenson's land eighty seven perches thence S.67<sup>d</sup> westerly by a line of trees one hundred twenty eight perches thence N.23<sup>d</sup> westerly by Maurice Stakers land eighty seven perches thence continuing by ye said Stakers land S.67<sup>d</sup> westerly ninety six perches to ye afore mentioned Muckernipate Creek thence up the severall courses there to ye place of begining being ~~three~~ hundred and twenty acres of land: The second pece beginneth at a corne<sup>r</sup> past of Hance Vrings land thence S.23<sup>d</sup> easterly by ye same ninety perches thence N.67<sup>d</sup> easterly by ye said Vrings land nine perches thence S.23<sup>d</sup> easterly by Maurice Stakers land sixty perches thence S.67<sup>d</sup> westerly by a line of trees one hundred fifty five perches to a corne<sup>r</sup> past thence N.23<sup>d</sup> westerly by Hance Vrings land sixty perches thence N.67<sup>d</sup> easterly -
