



Pursant to a Warr from Edward Pennington then Surveyor Generall bearing date the 9<sup>th</sup> day of the 9<sup>th</sup> M<sup>r</sup> 1770. 1701 directed unto me I do certify into the Generall Surveyor's office Now at Philadelphia that I have Resurveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> of Nov 2<sup>nd</sup> 1770 2<sup>nd</sup> 1702 unto Gunne Rumbo a certaine tract of land on the west side of Scoolkeel being within the bounds of Liticia Penns Marier beginning at a whit ok being a corner deviding it from Peeter Goke land from thence by a line of marked trees and ye same land East north east 712 perches to a Hickry marked by Scoolkeel River from thence by the sevral courses of ye same 238 perches to another corner Hickry marked deviding it from the Widdin Yeegums land from thence by a line of marked trees and ye same land with the land of John Hugh West south west 544 perches to a blak ok marked deviding it from the said John Hugh's land from thence by a line of marked trees deviding it from same other part of the said Marier north north west 150 perches to the place of beginning Containing six hundred and fourteen acres of land and is according to the bounds above described Returnid into ye abouesd officie the 18<sup>th</sup> day of the abouesd 2<sup>nd</sup> 1770.
